

A Guide for Choosing a Curriculum

1. Identify student need
 - a. Does the data indicate a need for a standardized Tier 2/3 intervention?
2. Review available published DI curricula
 - a. Popular curricula
 - i. Literacy
 - Language for Learning
 - Reading Mastery Signature Edition
 - Corrective Reading
 - ii. Math
 - Connecting Math Concepts
 - Essentials for Algebra
3. Evaluate school capacity to implement
 - a. Consider training, coaching, grouping, scheduling
4. Conduct pilot lessons with one or two small groups
 - a. Monitor student performance and implementer fidelity
5. Review data & decide
 - a. Can you expand to more groups? Do staff need more coaching or retraining?
6. Monitor with regular data reviews and fidelity checks.
